For Graff, a top manufacturer of faucets and shower hardware, Opizzi created Ametis, a line of faucets and showers based on the smooth, cascading lines of Japanese calligraphy. The shower, shaped in a wide, open circle, releases water in three manners. The faucet comes with a joystick attached to a base that changes color with water temperature — blue for cold, red for hot.
